

Micropigmentation Pre-Procedure Information

Pink Ink

Micropigmentation has lasting and immediate benefits. Hair loss from chemotherapy, aging or other medical conditions can be camouflaged by enhancing the patient's natural features.

- Eyeliner involves a lash enhancement that gives a natural look of fuller lashes.
- Eyebrows frame the face. Proper placement of brows will open up the eyes and often time change the appearance of the shape of the face.
- Lip Color can redefine an irregular lip line and bring restoration to color that has faded.
- Areola placement can complete the final step of breast reconstruction and restore well being.
- Scalp and scalp camouflaging can simulate surrounding skin and hair color.

Be prepared for the color intensity of your procedure to be significantly sharper, brighter or darker than what is expected for the final outcome. It will take time for this transition, based on how quickly the outer layer of your skin exfoliates.

Pre-Procedure Considerations:

- No alcohol or caffeine products 24 hours before treatment.
- No aspirin or blood thinning medications five (5) days prior.
- No medication should be discontinued without first consulting your physician.
- Make-up should be removed and the skin thoroughly cleansed before your appointment. For optimal results, the skin to be treated should not be irritated.
- If you use Retin A or other skin medications, please advise us.
- You make take Benadryl the night before and over the counter Advil or Aleve 30 minutes prior to appointment. Areas to be treated will be injected with lidocaine to provide a pain free treatment.
- If you have no existing tattoo/tattoos or will be having lip color, please arrange to stop by the office at least 24 hours before your procedure for a quick allergy test.

Specific Instructions

- **Eyeliner:** Patients should ***not plan to drive home or for the remainder of the day. Do not wear contact lenses on the day of procedure. Bring glasses and/or sunglasses to wear home.*** Initial _____
- **Lip:** Clients having a lip procedure with a history of cold sores/fever blisters/herpes, even if it was when you were a child, should ***call the office for a prescription of Valtrex to begin two days before your procedure.*** Bring your favorite lip stick/pencil with you. Exfoliation of the lips is helpful 2 - 3 days before. Use a toothbrush and Vaseline to gently exfoliate lips. Initial _____
- **Brow:** Any tweezing or hair removal of the brow line should be done 3 days before. Unwanted hair may be removed before so that it does not challenge the desired border of the brow. Brow patients may come with their brow pencil applied as desired and bring their brow pencil.
- **Areola:** Must have approval of plastic surgeon.
